Admission and Enrollment Instructions

1.0 We are pleased to inform you that you have been selected to join a training course in Arts at TaSUBa. The program will commence on 19th October 2026

1.1 You are required to:

a. For those selected by Tamisemi (Direct by Government)

- Confirm to join TaSUBa before 19th October 2026.
- A student who will not confirm to join TaSUBa by that date, that position will be allocated to another student.
- Confirm by writing your full name and the course you have been selected through the following contact. Mobile: 0766264581 or 0762544613

b. For those selected by institution

- Make sure you keep the code (MSIMBO) given by NACTVET so that you can submit to the registrar office when you arrive in the college.

2.0 Fees Payment

- All payments must be done through M-PESA, TIGO PESA, AIRTEL MONEY, NMB, or CRDB Bank. Request a CONTROL NUMBER during office hours by contacting 0710848594 or 0716072288.
- No student shall be allowed to register or attend classes unless the required fees and costs have been paid according to the fee structure instructions.

2.1 Documents for Registration

- Students shall be registered under the names appearing in the certificates submitted during the application process.

4. Students under Employment

- All students employed by the government are advised to settle their release from duties before reporting to TaSUBa.

5. Accommodation and Hostel Facilities

- TaSUBa has limited accommodation facilities. The policy supports both on-campus and off-campus living, with most students staying off-campus. Off-campus students must arrange their own accommodation. Assistance may be obtained from the Dean of Students' office at TaSUBa.
- On-campus accommodation should not be paid for until a room has been allocated. Rooms are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis after registration.
- Sponsors may arrange for the payment of meals, books, and stationery directly to their sponsees. Sponsors without a formal agreement with TaSUBa should pay directly to the student, not through TaSUBa.
